Aspidistra

Fully deserving of its common name, Cast Iron Plant, the Aspidistra is resilient, low maintenance and can tolerate a fair degree of neglect.

Sunlight: Choose a spot in moderate to low light and avoid positions in direct sun.

Water: Aspidistra is a drought-tolerant plant, so it doesn't need to be watered very often. During the growing season (spring and summer), water every 1-2 weeks, allowing the soil to dry out between waterings. During the winter, water only when the soil feels completely dry.

Humidity: This plant does well in average humidity. To increase humidity, mist the leaves or place in a naturally humid room, like a bathroom or kitchen.

Temperature: Between 10°C to 29°C.

Feed: Feed a couple of times per year in spring and summer with a balanced liquid feed.

Repotting: Aspidistra thrives on being pot-bound so only divide in spring when the pot is very overcrowded.

Top Tip: Make sure not to overwater!
